

## SVOS Arrangement Rules

1. Orchids must predominate and need not be grown by the exhibitor.
2. Other flowers, foliage, plant materials and accessories are permitted in all classes of the arrangements and corsage divisions .. No American flags.
3. All orchids, other flowers, and line material must be natural.
4. All entries should be entered and ready for judging by the end of registration on Friday evening (7:30 p.m.) except for corsages and flower arrangements that are not in water. These entries must be registered and in place by 7:30 a.m. Saturday. If possible, list flowers and other material used.
5. No entry may be removed from the show before 4:00 p.m. Sunday.
6. Entries and choice of class must be made by the exhibitor (an exhibitor may enter as many classes as desired.)
7. The exhibitor shall make the determination of whether or not to enter the novice class and shall make all entries in that class, which is for someone who has never won a blue ribbon at this show.
8. Comments by the judges will be exposed to the public after judging is completed.
9. All entries are eligible for ribbon awards in their categories. Judges have the discretion of withholding a first-, second-, or

third-place ribbon if, in their opinion, no entry within the given category meets judging standards.

10. Judging will be performed by Garden Club Judges. Classes 214 and 215 are open to the judges of this show.

200. The Plumber. -- An arrangement by a novice, someone who has never won a blue ribbon for their arrangement at this show.

201. The Farmer. - Designer's choice.

202. DNR Officer. - Designer's choice indicating a woodsy environment

203. The Bus Driver. - Three similar arrangements in a line.

204. The Garbage Collector. -- Designer's choice.

205. The Waitress -- A place setting for two no larger than 22 inches long or wide. (No silverware)

206. The Fire Fighter - Designer's Choice.

207. The Race Car Driver -- An arrangement suggesting motion.

208. The Entertainer. - Arrangement using just one orchid blossom.

209. The Life Guard. - Arrangement showing water.

210. The Pyrotechnist. - Design suggesting fireworks at least 18 inches in height.

211. The Jailer. - Designer's choice.

212. The Bartender. -- An arrangement not to exceed 9 inches in any direction

**213. The Jeweler. -- Arrangement not to exceed 5 inches in any direction.**

**214. The Teacher. - Open to judges of this show only.**

**215. The Electrician. - Open to judges of this show only.**
